bond of William Allen of Surry County for the sum of one
Thousand & fourteen pounds 17/1 & 2/2 payable on or before the
28 day of December one thousand Eight hundred as also for
and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand
paid the receipt of which I do hereby acknowledge & I the
Benj^d Drew being willing and desirous to indemnify my
securities in the aforesaid debt I the said Benjamin Drew
doth by these presents bargain sell alien make over & enjoin
unto them the s^d W^m Hines & Simon Boykin the following
property (Vizt) one tract or parcel of Land (it being the
plantation on which the said Drew now lives) containing
by a late survey nine hundred & eight acres be the same
more or less together with all and singular the improvements
on the said Land To have and to hold the said tract or parcels
of Land to them the said Hines & Boykin their heirs executors
and administrators to the only proper use and behoof of
them the s^d William Hines & Simon Boykin their heirs
and assigns forever - And the said Benj^d Drew doth
hereby make over bargain & sell unto them the said Hines
& Boykin two certain schooners known the one by the name
of the Industry of Smithfield the other by the name of the
Patley of Smithfield, together with all & singular the sails
and rigging belonging or in anywise appertaining to the
said Schooners or vessels and the said Drew doth by
these presents bargain sell and make over to the said
