fine nice looking glass & nine hair bottom chairs four
pictures one pair circular tables one bureau, one small
stand one large easy chair one nice press & one common
one — one desk two tables one small marble table six com-
mon Windsor chairs eight beds & furniture one cester complete
one large soup spoon 10 large silver table spoons eleven
small tea spoons two salvers & one small writing desk —
to have and to hold all and singular the aforesaid property
to them the said William Hines & Simon Boykin their
heirs and assigns forever — upon this special trust and
confidence however that if the said Benjamin Drew —
shall truly and faithfully pay, and satisfy, the said William
Allen the amount for which the said Hines & Boykin are
security, then the Interest & right herein conveyed to be
utterly null & void — and the said Benjamin Drew
and by these presents further agree that after the debt
due to William Allen is fully paid & satisfied that
then the residue of the property herein conveyed shall be
subject to indemnifying Simon Boykin for being my
security to Wharton Harrison for two thousand dollars to be
paid in the month of August next given under our hands
