This Indenture made this Fourteenth day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety Eight - Between Ethelred Lancaster and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and John Womble of Southampton County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Ethelred Lancaster and Elizabeth his wife hath for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John Womble at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Ethelred Lancaster & Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge they the said Ethelred Lancaster and Elizabeth his wife hath granted bargained and sold aliened Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said John Womble his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred and sixty acres of land be the same more or less situate lying and being on the south side of Tarpon swamp in Southampton County of Virginia and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a small Hickory a corner tree of Bailey & Lanchesters line standing on the old road thence along the old road a dividing line of Jordan & his heirs to a pine a corner of David Davies and mid Joseph of Bailey line thence along said Joseph of Baileys line to a red oak
