This Indenture made the sixth day of April one thousand Eight hundred Between Jacob Darden Jun^r of the one part; and John Glover Jun^r both of Southampton County on the other part Witnesseth that in consideration of one dollar to the said Jacob Darden Jun^r; in hand paid by the said John Glover Jr. at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Jacob Darden Jun^r hath granted bargained and sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said John Glover Jun^r his heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the county of Southampton bounded in the following manner (to wit) Beginning at a water oak in Joshua Gardners line thence along said line to a post oak tree of James Gardners Sen^r Joshua Gardner & Shadrach Griffin thence James Gardner Sen^r line to a red oak thence a straight line to the beginning Containing by Estimation Thirty or more or less with all the appurtenances Issues and profits and all liberties and privileges therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainings and remainders & all and singular the premises aforesaid which premises being a part of a certain tract or parcel of Land conveyed by the said John Glover Jun^r to the said Jacob Darden Jun^r In Trust to secure a debt due John Dorton as by Indenture bearing date To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the said appurtenances and all arise the These premises herein before mentioned to be hereby granted
