of Southampton County did purchase of Henry Barrow of  
the same place a certain tract of Land in the said County -  
containing Three hundred and forty four acres for the sum of one  
Thousand Dollars as will appear from a deed executed to me by  
him and of record in the county court aforesaid it being the same  
Land that formerly belonged to John Simmons and was sold by  
Isiah Wick as sheriff of the said county of Southampton to satisfy a  
debt due the commonwealth of Virginia - And whereas the said  
Land has again been levied on by Robt Mabry as sheriff of the  
said county to satisfy the debts of Taxes due from the said John  
Simmons to the publick and exposed to sale - and I the said Peter  
Simmons having instituted a suit against the tenant in possession  
in the district Court of Suffolk and recovered therein - and therefore  
having full confidence and reliance in the right & title of which  
I am possessed, and being willing to release the said Henry Barrow  
from all responsibility in consequence of his deed to me for my  
self, my heirs, executors and administrators, the said Henry Barrow  
his heirs, executors, and administrators from all suits, actions and dem-  
ands whatsoever either in Law or equity, do, shall, and will forever
