 the said Nathaniel Pierce for and in consideration of the just and
 full sum of six hundred and thirty one Dollars & twenty three Cents
 Current money of Virginia by the said Jordan Denon to him in
 hand paid before the inscribing & Delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof the said Nathaniel Pierce doth hereby acknowledge and thereby
 acquit and discharge the said Jordan Denon his heirs and assigns
 forever - and himself therewith fully and entirely satisfied con-
 tented and paid the said Nathaniel Pierce hath granted bargained
 sold, aliened, conveyed, released, set over, delivered and confirmed
 and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, convey, release
 set over, deliver and confirm unto Jordan Denon and to his heirs and
 assigns forever all that plantation, mesuage, tract and parcel of
 two hundred and twenty six Acres of land be the same more
 or less, whereon Spencer Pierce lately lived and being the land
 that the said Jordan Denon sold to the said Nathaniel Pierce by
 deed of Indenture bearing date August the first one thousand eight
 hundred bounded and described by the said Indenture is expressed
 declared and lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish
 of Nottoway aforesaid and all the houses out houses edifices
