This Indenture made this fifth day of August in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred between
 Jordan Denson of the County of Southampton of the one
 part and Nathaniel Pierce of the same County of the other
 part, Witnesseth that the said Jordan Denson for and in
 consideration of the just and full sum of Six hundred and eighty
 dollars to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel Pierce before the
 signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
 said Jordan Denson doth hereby acknowledge and thereupon
 and discharge the said Nathaniel Pierce, his heirs and assigns forever and
 himself therewith fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid hath
 granted bargained sold aliened enoffed released & over delivered and
 confirmed; and by these presents do garant bargain sell alien re-
 off releas & over deliver and confirm unto the said Nathaniel
 Pierce and to his heirs and assigns forever All that plantation
 meysuage tract and parcel of Land situate lying and being in the
 County of Southampton aforesaid and being the plantation & land
 which the said Jordan Denson purchased of Spencer Pierce by Inven-
 ture bearing date in February 1800 bounded and delivered as by
 the said deed is expressed and said to contain by a late witness
