come I Charles Wellons do send greeting Know ye that I the
Charles Wellons of the parish of Sotterway in the County of
Southampton for and in consideration of the love goodwill
and affection which I have and do bear towards my loving
son Rob^t. Wellons of the same parish and County of South
ampton have given and granted and by these presents do
freely give and grant unto the Rob^t. Wellons his heirs &
& adm^rs forever one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the
aforesaid County of Southampton on the south side of Round Hill
Swamp containing by Estimation one hundred acres more or
less and bounded as follows (To wit) Beginning at a sweet
Gum in the Mill pond thence up the s^d. Mill pond to a Holly
Thence to round Hill Swamp thence down the s^d. Round Hill
Swamp to the first Station - And all houses - outhouses - Cattle
Buildings - yards - Gardens - Orchards - Woods - Underwoods - Trees - ways
Waters - watercourses - profits - Commodities - Hereditaments and
Appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or
in any wise appertaining the same and the reversion & reversions
