This Indenture made this 10th day of September in
the year of our Lord Christ 1800 Between Henry Crofford of the
County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part and
Howell Barrow Jr of the county of Southampton and State of
North Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Henry Crofford for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
and sixty five pounds Virginia Currency to him in hand paid
before the enrolling and delivery hereof by the said Howell Barrow
the receipt whereof heath hereby acknowledge and himself fully
satisfied and paid hath given granted and sold Aliened Enfeoffed
released conveyed and confirmed unto the said Howell Barrow
his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land situate
lying and being in the county of Southampton and State of
Virginia on the south side of Meherrin River and bounded as
follows (Viz) beginning at a hickory on the bank of Meherrin
river where the Patent called for a white oak then running south
East by East Ninety six poles to two pine saplings then south one
hundred and twenty six Poles to the new County line which now
divides the State of Virginia from North Carolina to a pine stump
