of August one thousand eight hundred and one Between
Abbigdon Braine and Peggy Braine his wife of the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
Saml Braine of the County and State aforesaid of the other
part Witnesseth that Abbigdon Braine and Peggy his
wife for and in the consideration of the sum of three hundred
and thirty pounds current money of Virginia to them in
