Know all men by these presents that I, Bath: Peterson <sup>son of John</sup>  
Peterson died of the county of Brunswick in the colony & dominion of Virginia  
am held and firmly bound unto Horrell Edmunds Jr. of the county of  
Northampton in the province of North Carolina on the full & just  
sum of five hundred pounds <sup>of</sup> money to which payment such  
shully to be made I bind myself my heirs executors & administrators  
jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with my seals  
dated this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1769.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas Horrell  
Edmunds purchased of the above bound Bath: Peterson son of John  
Peterson died a certain tract of land lying on Meherrin river below  
Crafts bridge for the sum of one hundred & fifty six pounds seven  
shillings and six pence current money of Virginia now if the obli-  
gation above bound Bath: Peterson do and shall well truly make the  
s<sup>r</sup>. Horrell Edmunds Jr. his heirs or assigns a lawful right to the said  
tract of land when required without fraud then the above obligation  
be void or else to remain in full force power & virtue
