This Indenture made this nineteenth day of Oct:
Anno Domini one thousand Eight Hundred -
Between Henry Ramsey and Mary his wife Sarah eldys
and Mary his wife Burwill Westbuck and Catharine his
wife John Moore and Temperance his wife of the one part
and James Ramsey of the County of Southampton of the other
Part, Witnesseth that whereas Lydia Ramsey dec'd was at
her death Seized and Possessed of one certain Tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
containing one hundred and thirty Acres more or less and bounded
as follows (Vizt.) Beginning at a red oak in the line of John
McMour dec'd thence South by a line of Thomas Cliftens dec'd
to a red oak a corner tree thence North by Thomas Turners line
to a white oak a corner of the said land formerly belonging
to Henry Harris thence east to a red oak a corner of the land
belonging to John Morgan dec'd thence by the line of John
Gandy dec'd and John Drips line to the beginning - and the said
Lydia Ramsey did by her last will in writing give & bequeath the
said tract and parcel of Land unto the aforesaid James Ramsey
but the said will in writing for want of proper witnesses
or some other impediment being to be admitted to be a will
