Blum Jr. and Polly Smith as to Garratt Morgan & by the oath of Wiley Francis as to Henry Ramsey & Burwell Westbrook and acknowledged by John Moore party hereto and at a court held for the said county in Jan^r 1801 The said Indenture was acknowledged by Catherine Ramsey and Temperance Moore being first examined as the Law directs and ordered to be recorded —

Know all men by these presents that I William Pebworth of Southampton county for and in consideration of the sum of fifty two pounds Current Money of Virginia do bargain and sell to Willis Washington of the The aforesaid county his heirs and assigns the following property to wit, one single Riding Chair one Silver Tea one pair of Iron bound Cart wheels one Cart with the cover & gear & one bay Mare and one gray horse. Which I oblige myself, my heirs and assigns to deliver to the aforesaid Willis Washington his order and will Warrant and flavor defend all right title claim or Interest of any person or persons whatsoever of any part or part of the aforesaid mentioned property In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 26th day of May 1800 —

The Conditions of the above obligation is such that if the above bound William Pebworth do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the aforesaid Willis Washington the just Sum of Twenty Six pounds like current money aforesaid on or before the 26th day of July next then the above obligation and agreement to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
