This Indenture made this 19th day of January
 in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & one
 Between William Gilliam and Mary Gilliam his wife
 of Sussex County and William Butts of Southampton
 of the other part Witnefs that for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and Thirteen pounds five shillings
 to him the said William Gilliam and Mary Gilliam
 his wife in hand paid the receipt whereof they do hereby
 acknowledge hath granted Bargained and sold and do hereby
 by these presents grant Bargain and Sell unto William Butts
 his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land
 lying and being in Southampton County on the south side of
 Kottoway River containing by estimation one hundred and
 fifty one acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
 Beginning at the mouth of Spring branch on the North
 Side of the Raccoon Swamp thence down the said Stream
 Kottoway River thence up the said River to a Hickory
 corner of the Land formerly belonging to Tho^s Gilliam
