part and Thomas Harrison of said county and State aforesaid

to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Harrison the receipt
whereof is fully acknowledged, and that the said John Stur-
geon doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied and paid
for the same hath granted bargained sold enfeoffed and confirmed by
these presents doth grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm
