

with hereby absolutely gave grant, set over and deliver unto the
said Polly Bart one Negro Woman named Linnah and all
her future increase. And whereas the said William Bart hath in-
vested the comfortable support of the said Bramble Hunnicutt
as aforesaid now therefore the said Bramble Hunnicutt
with hereby, vest in the hands of the said Mr Bart the follow-
ing Negroes (to wit) Annica, Nanny, Mimy, Jenny, & Arny, with
all their future increase, to continue in theiral service
and for the benefit of the said William Bart during his
natural life together with all the debts or estate belonging
to the said Hunnicutt in any wise whatsoever provide he shall
timely faithfully support and maintain the said Hunnicutt in a
manner which may be deemed comfortable as to diet clothing
&c. and also to pay all debts due from the said Hunnicutt for any
of her former transactions being legally established. Should
the said William Bart have other child or children, lawfully
begotten of his body and should he cause to make and execute a
last will and Testament then shall the said Negroes with their in-
crease be subject to such equal distribution as he may see
fit. But in no other case shall the said William
dispose of the said Negroes or their increase during the
life of the said Polly Bart. But should the said Polly Bart
depart this life before the said William Bart leaving no issue then
shall all the said Negroes with their increase be the absolute property
of the said William Bart to dispose of by will or otherwise as to
him may seem good. But never theless should the said William Bart fail
to comply with his part of this contract and the same be manifest
then in that case the last mentioned Negroes, Annica, Nanny,
Mimy, Jenny, & Arny, shall retain to and be at the direct
disposal of contract of the said Bramble Hunnicutt to
procure such comfortable support or to pay such debts as the
said
