with by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the
said Samuel Jones his heirs and assigns forever all
all his right and title to the Land which he the said
Joseph Jones claims by virtue of his Father's last will
and Testament together with all houses gardens ways water-
courses commons and appurtenances thereto belong-
ing and the reversion and reversions hereunder and
unannounced rents Issues and Services thereof also all
the Estate Right title Interest profits Claim and
revenue whatsoever of the said Joseph Jones and his heirs
& assigns to the same or any part thereof. To have and to
hold the same Land with all and singular appurtenances
thereto belonging unto the said Samuel Jones his heirs
and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof
of him the said Samuel Jones his heirs & assigns
