tioned, expressed and declared of and concerning the same; that is to
say, to the use and behoof of the said Benjamin E. Browne &
Mary Mason, his wife, & the survivor of them, for and during
their natural life, without impeachment of, or for any manner
of waste, and, from and after the decease of the said Benjamin
E. Browne and Mary, his wife, then to the use and behoof of
William Henry Browne, the youngest son of the said Benjamin
and Mary, & his heirs forever, but in case he should die before he
