Southampton County, The commonwealth of Virginia to Sam^l Killo and William Blount Gentlemen greeting whereas Sam^l Killo and Margaret his Wife have by this Certain Indenture of bargain and sale dated the 20th day of April 1801 conveyed unto Robert Exum of the County of Southampton the fee simple estate of and in 80 acres of land now known ye that whereas the said Margaret cannot convene unto the court of our said County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgments which the said Margaret shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do therefore command you to go personally to the said Margaret and receive her acknowledgment of the same and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she hath executed the said deed freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her husband and whether she is willing the said indenture should be recorded in the court of our said County of Southampton and when you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgment of the said Indenture that you distinctly openly certify the same under your hands & seals returning to us also the said Indenture annexed, Witness Sam^l Killo Clerk of our said County at his office this 17th August 1801 - Sam^l Killo &
