Melchisedec Pitman Seal

At a court held for the county of Southampton the 20<sup>th</sup> day of  
April 1801 - This deed was acknowledged by Melchisedec Pitman the party hereto and caused to be recorded -

This Indenture made on the third day of March eighteen hundred and one between Iype Crocker and Polly his wife, formerly Lane  
of the one part and Melchisedec Pitman of the other Part all  
of the county of Southampton - Witnesseth that the said Iype and  
Polly in Consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars in  
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given  
granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do give grant  
bargain, and sell unto the said Melchisedec Pitman and his  
heirs all the estate in remainder of my, and to thre, hundred  
acres and one sixth part of an acre of land be the  
same lying in the County of Southampton being the one  
moity of a certain tract, or parcel of land lately surveyed by  
William H. in as reference to the said survey will fully appear  
by the same land and premises to which the said Iype and Polly became  
entitled in remainder in right of the said Polly by descent from her  
mother Lucy Lane, and Jones who was thereof seized in his domains as  
of fee by inheritance from her Father Joseph Jones deceased -  
to have and to hold the said tract or moiety of a tract or par-  
cel of land as above described to him the said Melchisedec Pitman  
and his heirs and the said Iype and Polly for themselves, and  
each of their joint and several heirs, Executors and Administrators  
of the said moiety, or parcel of land in remainder with all its appur-  
tenances unto him the said Melchisedec Pitman his heirs & assigns
