This Indenture made on the third day of March eighteen hun-
dred and one between Jesse Crocker and Polly his wife formerly Lane
of the one part and Melchisedec Pitman of the other Part all
of the county of Southampton— Witnesseth that the said Jesse and
Polly in Consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars in
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given
granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do give grant
bargain, and sell unto the said Melchisedec Pitman and his
heirs all the estate in remainder of, and unto three hundred
and one acres and one sixth part of an acre of land be the
same more or less, lying in the County of Southampton being the one
moiety of a certain Tract, or parcel of Land lately surveyed by
William Wren as reference to the said survey will fully appear
being the same land and premises to which the said Jesse and Polly became
entitled in remainder in right of the said Polly by descent from her
mother Lucy Lane, and Son who was thereof seized in his demise as
of fee, by instantance from her Father Joseph Lane deceased —
to have and to hold the said tract or moiety of a tract or par-
cel of Land as above described to him the said Melchisedec Pitman
and his heirs and the said Jesse and Polly for themselves, and
each of their joint and several heirs Executors and Administrators
the said moiety or parcel of land in remainder with all its apper-
tenances unto him the said Melchisedec Pitman his heirs & assigns
