

This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of September in the year of our lord one thousand Eight hundred

Between Byrd Lundy of the county of Southampton of the one part and William Wright of the county aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds current money to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he the said Byrd Lundy, with here by acknowledges, he the said Byrd Lundy hath granted and sold alien & confirm, and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said William Wright his Heirs and assigns One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Hampton aforesaid and bounded as follows, Beginning at a stooping oak made a corner in the said Lundy's line thence along the said Byrd Lundy and William Wright's line to a corner Pine in Henry Tiller's line thence along the said Lundy and Henry Tiller to a red Oak in the said Wright's line thence along the Wright's line to a branch to a white oak a corner thence along the said Wright's line to a new chopped line thence along the said new chopped line to the beginning containing by estimation fifty one acres be the same or less, with all woods ways waters water courses Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to same belonging or in any wise appertaining the reversion and reversions remainders or remainders and Issues and profits thereof, and all the estate right title Interest Property claim or demand whatsoever of him the said Byrd Lundy and to the same and every part thereof I.C. have and hold the said Tract of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof with all and singular the Premises unto the said William Wright his Heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Wright his Heirs and assigns, and the said Byrd Lundy the said Tract of Land and Premises and Every Part thereof unto the said William Wright his Heirs & assigns shall and will Warrant and defend against the
