direction of him till he doth arrive to the age of twenty one
Years then I do for my self my heirs Executors and administra-
tors Relinquish all my right interest and claim or pre-
tensions of Claim whatsoever either to his person or to any
Estate he may hereafter acquire after he shall attain to the
full and lawful age, that he may enjoy his full free-
dom without any interruption from me or any other person whatsoever —
