 This Indenture made this 16th day of August in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred between Benjamin Drew and Mary his wife of the county of Southampton of the one part and William Urquhart of the same County of the other part, Witneseth that the said Benjamin Drew and Mary his Wife for & in Consideration of the sum of One Hundred dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the sealing or delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Drew and Mary his Wife doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit and discharge the said William Urquhart his heirs and assigns forever hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell one certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county aforesaid containing by estimation Fifty Acres more or less and bounded as follows beginning together with all the appurtenances belonging thereto (which tract or parcel of Land the said Benj^r Drew bot of Thomas Combs) To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances unto the said William Urquhart his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Drew & Mary his wife for themselves and their heirs doth covenant and agree to & with the said Wm^r Urquhart his heirs and assigns shall and may at all times hereafter quietly and peaceably enjoy & possess the above mentioned Land and premises free from all incumbrance whatsoever & that the said Benjamin Drew & Mary his Wife the said tract or parcel of Land doth forever Warrant & release from all person or Persons whatsoever claiming under them
