 parcel of land and being in the county of Southampton adjoining the land
 of Glishes Whitley John Laurence, Joshua Whitley and black
 Water River being the same land that devolved to the said Mary
 Holmes by the death of her son William Laurence containing three
 hundred & nine acres and one quarter, be the same more or less
 and also lands, trees woods, underwoods, canons, ways pasturage,
 commonities, servitudes, hereditaments, waters & water courses and
 all its appurtenances whatever to the said Mefuay or tenants
 and premises above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertain-
 ing, and also the reversion & reversions, remainder & remainders rents
 and services of the said premises and of every part thereof, and all the
 estate, right, title, interest, claim, and demands whatsoever in and
 to the said bargained premises unto the said Mills Laurence
 his heirs Executors and assigns with all rights titles, claims or demands
 which the said Mary Holmes doth now possess or hereafter may
 possess and to any of the land appurtenance or any part of the said
 tract which was taken from a tract by a decree of Court but
 doubt having arose whether the said division was conducted legal or

 tract (known by the name of the Wasing place land) it being
 the property formerly of John Laurence and his band to the said
