Examination of
deed of Jacob Darden
January 1811

This Indenture made this tenth day of January in the Year of
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & one between Jacob Darden
Squire & Patience his wife of Southampton County and state of
Virginia, of the one part, & John Lee of the County & state aforesaid
of the other part, Witnesses, that they the said Jacob Darden
and Patience his wife for in consideration of the sum of twenty
seven pounds Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid
by the said John Lee, before the unsealing & delivery of these
premises, the Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge & them
selves to be therewith fully Satisfied & contented & paid; have gran-
ted, sold, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed, & by these pre-
sents do grant, bargain sell alien, convey & confirm unto the
said John Lee his heirs & assigns for ever a certain parcel of
land being in Southampton County on the East side the
Cedar Swamp, bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Cypress
a cypress tree standing in the cedar swamp near and below said
Lee's mill dam, thence westerly along a small distance below said
dam, along a line of marked trees to a small oak a corner, thence
westerly along a line of marked trees to a pine a corner on the
side of a pond thence crossing the pond along a line of marked
trees to a corner pine near the side of the sandy branch, thence
along a line of marked trees to a black gum standing
