This Indenture made this 17th day of October in the year of our
lord one thousand Eight hundred between Henry Taylor of the County
of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Lewis
Fort of the aforesaid County and state of the other part. Whereas
the said Henry Taylor is and justly indebted to the said Lewis Fort
for being security for said Taylor in a bond given to Henry Throp
for one hundred and forty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to
secure the said Throp from any claim coming against him from
the Heirs of John Throp dec^d for a Negro man named George sold
him by the said Henry Taylor he being willing that the said
Lewis Fort should be secured from all damage that may arise
from his being security for the said Henry Taylor as afore said
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for securing and saving
himself the said Lewis Fort from all damage that may arise
to him or his Heirs the said Henry Taylor for and in consideration
of the sum of five shillings by the said Lewis Fort to him in hand
Paid, the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge &
for securing the payment of the aforesaid sum of one hundred and
forty Pounds with Interest to the said Lewis Fort he the said Henry
Taylor doth bargain and sell & by these presents doth bargain and
sell unto Robert Goodwin Thos Ridley Ellis G. Blake one certain tract
or parcel of land lying the tract whereon the said Henry Taylor now
live adjoining Ellis Gray Blake's land John Wright son and Son's
Lewis containing four hundred Acres of the said more or less
To have and to hold the said bargain'd premises unto the
said Robert Goodwin Thos Ridley Ellis G. Blake their heirs
forever but upon this express proviso in trust and confidence
for the said Henry Taylor should the Heirs of John Throp
dec^d recover the said Negro George from Henry Throp & the
said Lewis Fort suffer & pay the aforesaid sum of one hun-
dred and forty Pounds & so then the said tract shall
