 dred & forty eight Dollars have granted and by these presents
 do grant and confirm unto the s^d Pilgrim Vick his heirs and
 assigns one moiety of a certain tract of parcel of land lying
 and being on the south side of Arthurs Swamp & bounded to wit
 Beginning at a post oak in John Whitefields line a corner tree
 thence North thirty five Degrees West to Arthurs Swamp; then
 by the run of s^d swamp to John Rawlces line thence by Rawlces
 lines to Whiteheads line thence by Jas. Magette line to the
 beginning in or near Whitefields line containing one hundred
 74 acres with all privileges and appurtenances therunto be
 = longing To have and to hold the above demised land
 and premises to him the said Pilgrim Vick his heirs and assigns
 ever and the said Benjamin Jordan and Mourning his wife
 doth covenant and agree with him the s^d Pilgrim Vick his
 heirs and assigns that the said Land is and so shall re
