ampton and Parish of Nottoway of the one part and Albrighton
Jones of the county and Parish aforesaid of the other part Wit-
ness that the said Jose W. Moore and Martha his wife for and
in consideration of the just and full sum of Five hundred
Dollars Current Money of Virginia by the said Albrighton
Jones to him in hand paid before before the ensuing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof says
the said Jose W. Moore and Martha his wife and back-
singe and thereof acquit and discharge the said Albrighton
Jones his heirs and assigns forever and themselves =
