erty to wit Three feather Beds and Furniture, one Desk and wash-
stand, one Table, one Dressing Table, one pine Table, one Sofa, nine
chairs. And the rest of my Household and Kitchen Furniture, Plan-
tation utensils &c. My Carpenters and Joiners Tools, one Mans Saddle,
Three heads of Horses, Five heads of Cattle, Thirty head of Hogs
and Thirty Barrels of Indian Corn To have and to hold unto
the said Richard P. Clements the aforesaid property to the only
proper use and behoof of him the said Richard P. Clements his
heirs and assigns for ever, in special trust and confidence to the
intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of Seventy Four
Pounds eight pence one farthing, shall remain unpaid to the said
Henry Barlow his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns at or upon
the first day of March next ensuing that then the said Richard P.
Clements his heirs Executors or Administrators shall after giving a rea-
sonable notice expose the aforesaid property to public sale at
any time after the Twentieth of March and with the money thence
arising first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum with Interest
and costs as also the expence attending the Execution of trust and
the surplus if any return to me the said John Barlow my heirs
Executors or Administrators In Testimony whereof the said
