This Indenture made this nineteenth day July in the
 Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one between Al-
 bredington Jones and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton
 and Parish of Netley of the one part and Jordan Denson of
 the County & Parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that
 the said Albredington Jones & Mary his wife for an inconsidera-
 -tion of the just and full sum of Five hundred and fifty Dollars
 current money of Virginia by the said Jordan Denson to them
 in hand paid before the unsealing and delivery of these pre-
 -sents the receipt whereof they the said Albredington Jones and
 Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & dis-
 -charge the said Jordan Denson his heirs and assigns forever and
 themselves therewith fully & entirely satisfied contented and paid
 they the said Albredington Jones & Mary his wife hath granted for-
 -given sold aliened inclosed released set over delivered & confir-
 -med by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien & release
 unto him the said Jordan Denson & to
 his heirs forever all that plantation meadow tract
 & parcel of land situate lying & being in the County of Southampton
 and parish of Netley aforesaid wherein Elizabeth Gray lately
 dwelt subject to the town of the said Elizabeth Gray being all the
 times which the said Albredington Jones purchased of the said
 Jesse W. Moore by indenture bearing date March Eighteen hundred
 and one which the said Jesse W. Moore bought of Jacob J. J. J. J.
 -anture bearing date January one thousand seven hundred and
 ninety three containing by estimation one hundred & forty or
 -could be the same more or less but by a late Mensuration said
 to contain two hundred acres & bounded as follows: To wit begin-
 -ing in the said Jordan Denson's line at a white oak in a small
 branch thence by the said line it being the pattern line to
