 Samuel Calvert and Jacob Darden jr. Gentlemen justices of the
 Peace whereas Albrigton Jones & Mary his wife have by their
 certain indenture of bargain and sale dated the 19th day of July
 1801 conveyed unto Jordan Denson of this County the fee simple
 estate of and in 200 acres of land with the appurtenances lying
 and being in the County aforesaid and whereas the said Mary
 cannot conveniently travel to the court of our said County of
 Southampton to acknowledge the same therefore we do give you pow-
 er to receive the acknowledgment which the said Mary shall
 be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid con-
 tained in the said indenture which is here to annexed and
 we do therefore command you to go personally to the said Mary
 and receive her acknowledgment of the same and examine
 her privately and apart from her said husband whether she
 hath consented the said deed freely and voluntarily without the per-
 suasion or threat of her husband and whether she is willing the
 said indenture should be recorded in the court of our said
 County of Southampton and when you have examined her as afo-
 re said and taken her acknowledgment of the said indenture that
 you distinctly and openly certify us thereof under your hands
 and seals returning to us also this writ with the said inden-
 ture and a true copy thereof to be made by Samuel Kello clerk of our said court at his
 Office on the 20th day of July 1801 in the 25th year of our Foundation
