 love 1801 Between Nicholas Williams of Southampton County of
 the one part and Spratty Williams of the aforesaid County of

 by the said Spratty Williams the Receipt whereof the said Nicholas
 Williams hath granted Bargained and sold unto the said Spratty Williams his heirs and assigns forever
 certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation 100 Hun
 dreds & three Acres by the same more or less situate lying and being
 in the County of Southampton on the North side of the aforesaid
 road swamp and bounded as follows Viz^t Beginning at a pine in
 the meadow in Robt Goarwins line thence along Goarwins
 line N 79° W two hundred & 15 pole to a corner pine in the Inman
 line thence N 47° E three hundred & 24 pole along the Inman
 line to a corner oak thence nearly South to the beginning
 Pine or first Station and also all trees woods under woods
