

Sauce Lazarus book for, in consideration of the sum of Ninety Eight pounds two Shillings to the said Lazarus Lobbin hand paid by the said Clarisy Whitehead the receipt whereof the Lazarus book doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien endoff and deliver unto the said Clarisy Whitehead her Heirs &c a certain Tract of Land lying in the County of Campton it being apart of the land that William Whitehead dec^d seiz^d of containing one hundred and nine Acres and bounded as followeth Beginning at the mouth of the first pond branch thence up the said fish pond branch along the Widows dower line to a white oak at the head of said branch then south one Hundred and sixteen Poles to the mill branch then down the mill branch sixty Poles to a pine then north seventy six Poles to a small branch then down the branch which divides the land formerly belonging to Harayana Neal Atkinson to Blunts swamp then up the swamp to the mouth of the pond branch a line of lot N^o one then up the branch to the Beginning To have and to hold the said land and premises with all the appertinances thereunto belonging unto the said Clarisy Whitehead and to her heirs forever and the said Lazarus book and his Wife Elizabeth book doth for themselves their heirs & forever warrant and defend the title of the said land against all and every person or persons who whatsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof to the said Clarisy Whitehead and her heirs the said Lazarus book and Elizabeth book hereunto have set their hands and affixed their Seals the day and year first above written—
