

This Indenture made on the 19th day October in the year of one
Thousand eight and one between William Bailey and Solomon

Holmes of Southampton County acting commissioners appointed
by the court of the said County, in Chancery sitting of the one
Part and William Boykin of the same County of the other part
Witness that the said William Bailey and Solomon
Holmes in virtue of a decree and order of the aforesaid court
bearing date in the month of July one Thousand eight
hundred and one as reference thereto being had will fully
appear and also in consideration of the sum of three hun-
-dred Dollars for which bond and security hath been given
-ous in one moiety thereof to wit in the sum of one hun-
-dred and fifty Dollars being half the value of a certain
tract or parcel of land devised by John Summerall of South
ampton County to his sons George and Samuel Now
Therefore the said William Bailey and Solomon Holmes have
given, granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do
give, grant, bargain, and sell unto the said William Boykin
and his heirs the aforesaid tract, or parcel of land lying in
the County aforesaid containing seventy five acres
be the same more or less; To have and to hold the said
tract or parcel of land with its appertinances to him the
said William Boykin and his heirs and the said William
Bailey and Solomon Holmes in pursuance of their authority as
Commissioners aforesaid the said tract or parcel of Land
with its appertinances unto him the said William Boykin
his heirs and assigns do warrant and defend in evidence
whereof they have hereunto set their hands and Seals the
