Cars to John Johnson and Sarah his wife of the County of Southampton
Deliverd and Parish of Notteaway for and in consideration of the sum of
to Seventy three Dollars & fifty Cents good and lawful money of
Johnson Virginia, in hand paid by Abraham Barr, the Releasor whereof
the said John Johnson and Sarah his wife doth acknowledge
them selves infinitely satisfied and paid doth grant, bargain
have sold, Aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth
bargain, sell, alien and confirm unto the said Abraham Barr
his heirs and assigns A certain tract or parcel land situated
lying and being in the aforesaid Parish, and County on the north
side of the main Black Creek containing by Estimation Thirtysix
One acres be the same more or less and bounded as follow
Beginning at the place now called the Dam to Branch formerly
called the Frog pen Branch at the mouth of a small Branch
that discharges into said Branch running thence the various
Courses of said Dam Branch to a black gum a corner tree in
Penelope Johnsons line running thence South 60° =
44' 4" —
