This Indenture made this seventeenth day of October in the
Year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and one Witnesseth
that John Johnson and Sarah his wife of the County of Hampton
and parish of Nottoway for and in consideration of the sum of
seventy three Dollars & fifty cents good and lawful money of
Virginia, in hand paid by Abraham Carr, the Receipt whereof
the said John Johnson and Sarah his wife doth acknowledge
themselves infinitely satisfied and paid doth grant, bargain &
have, sold, Alien and confirmed and by these presents doth
bargain, sell, Alien and confirm unto the said Abraham Carr
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated
lying and being in the aforesaid parish, and County on the north
Side of the main Black Creek containing by Estimation Thirty
One Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
Beginning at the place now called the Dam Branch formerly
called the Hog pen Branch at the mouth of a small Branch
that discharges into said Branch running thence the various
Courses of said Dam Branch to a Black gum a corner between
Penelope Johnsons line running thence South 60°
