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His Indenture made this fifth day of March in the
 Year of our Lord Christ, one thousand seven hundred and
 ninety seven. Between Simmons Vick and his wife of the
 County of Southampton, and state of Virginia of the one part
 and Josiah Vick of the same County and state of the other part
 Witne'soth, that the said Simmons Vick and his wife for and
 in Consideration of the sum of Fifty Pounds Current money,
 of the state of Virginia to them in hand paid By the
 said Josiah Vick, at & before the signing, Sealing & delivery
 of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Simmons
 Vick and his wife doth hereby acknowledge, & themselves
 therewith fully satisfied contented and paid, have bargained
 sold, aliened, infeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents
 doth hereby bargain sell, alien, infeoff, and forever confirm
 unto the said Josiah Vick, his heirs and assigns, one certain
 tract or parcel of land, lying and being Situate in the County
 of Southampton and state of Virginia to wit, Beginning at
 the mouth of the Creek at the Three Cypress Bridge thence
 a Crope the Creek, and binding up the river, wth Woodards
 line, thence binding the said Woodards line, and eastward
 to the high Neck, thence binding on the high Neck
 the said Josiah Vicks line & a Crope from the Neck to a
 white oak a corner tree, of the said Josiah Vicks, standing
 on the bank of the Hill and the said Simmons Vicks, thence
 running the main Road on the hill side to a Sycamore tree
 standing in a bottom at the mouth of the Island field on
 wheat patch path, thence a straight line to the South
 corner of the said high Neck thence a west Course a line
 of Marked Trees to be laid off binding on the high ground
 around the said Island field or wheat Patch to the head of
 the Creek, thence binding on the said Creek to the first
 station, containing Sixty five acres to the same more or less
 in the said Josiah Vick his heirs & hath the liberty of running
 and keep standing a fence from the said Sycamore
 Tree above mentioned immediately on the roadside opposite
