This Indenture, made this sixteenth day of October in the
Year one thousand eight hundred and one Between
Joshua Slade and Sarah his wife of the parish of Stokenay &
County of Southampton of the one part & Amos Gardner of the same
parish and County of the other part Witnesseth, that he the said
Joshua Slade and Sarah his wife for & in Consideration of the sum
of thirty two pounds current Money of Virginia to them here
paid at or before the making of delivery of these presents the
Receipt whereof the said Joshua Slade and Sarah his wife doth hereby
acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Amos
Gardner, his Heirs Executors and administrators, by these presents
he the said Joshua Slade and Sarah his wife hath granted sold
gained sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and
sell unto the said Amos Gardner and to his Heirs or assigns or
their one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the parish
and County aforesaid containing by estimation thirty three acres
