This Indenture made this sixteenth day of October in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one Between
Isel Pope and Sarah his wife of the county of Sampson and state
of Virginia of the one part and Nathan Pope of the aforesaid county
and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isel Pope
and Sarah his wife do acknowledge and own themselves fully
satisfied and content therewith for the sum of one thousand
and five hundred dollars and one half Current Money of Virginia
to them in hand paid, and thereupon have given granted bargained
sold aliened in good and confirmed and by these presents do give grant
bargain, sell, alien in feoff and confirm unto the said Nathan
Pope his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the county aforesaid containing by estimation
thirty seven and one half acres be the same more or less and bounded
as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine in said Nathan Pope's line then
North Thirteen degrees West Thirty pole to a Pine thence North
Forty three degrees east one hundred twenty four poles to
Lightwood Swamp or post thence south nineteen degrees
East Fifty pole to a Branch thence south Fifty degrees
East twenty pole across the said Branch thence to the Beginning
