by the said Jesse Holt Jr. at or before the en sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge
have given and granted, and by these presents do give and
grant unto the said Jesse Holt his Executors, administrators
and assigns, Five head of Cattle, one Mare, Three feather
Beds and furniture, Three Iron pots skillet, spider and
Dutch oven, pair of Pistols and smooth board Gun one
Watch silver loom and gear, Four pine chests, Woolen and
Flax wheel one of each half dozen of plain Chairs, parcel of
Pewter and earthen ware and parcel of Tools, two pine Tables
To have and to hold the said property unto him the said
Jesse Holt his Executors, Administrators and assigns forever
And the said Joseph Nuzworthy for himself his Executors
Administrators, the said property unto the said Jesse Holt
his Executors Administrators or assigns, against the Claim
of him the said Joseph Nuzworthy his Executors and Admini-
strators and against the Claim or Claims, of all and every
person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and
convey defend by them these presents In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this ninth
day of July Eighteen hundred and one
