This Indenture made this 19th day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred & one between Edward Stephenson of the county of Hampton of the one part and William Urquhart of the same County of the other part. Witness that the said Edmund Stephenson being indebted to the said William Urquhart in the sum of one hundred and sixteen pounds three Shillings and eight pence and being willing to secure the same with Interest thereon from this date to the said William Urquhart his heirs & assigns hath by these presents in consideration of the above Debt and Interest the said Edmund Stephenson doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said William Urquhart and his Heirs hath granted bargained and sold unto the said William Urquhart the Tract of Land he now lives on lately purchased of Benjⁿ Allen and known by the same bounds as aforesaid and acceded to him in Southampton Court also one Horse five Battle Twenty Hogs Two Beds and Furniture and all other Household and Kitchen Furniture in possession of him the said Edmund Stephenson for the purpose above mentioned that is to say in trust after advertising the property one Month at the Court house aforesaid of the said County to be sold to the highest bidder for the purpose above mentioned in the first place to discharge the said debt and Interest and the residue if any, to be retained to the said Edmund Stephenson his heirs or assigns In Witness whereof the said Edmund Stephenson hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and Year above Written —
