This Indenture made this twenty first day of December in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred & one, Between John Johnson Jr. and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Jordan Johnson of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said John Johnson Jr. and Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they do hereby Acknowledge have bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby bargain, sell, alien, convey, and forever confirm unto the said Jordan Johnson his heirs or assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being situate in the County of Southampton and parish of St. Lukes bounded as follows, Beginning at a red Oak a corner tree adjoining Thomas Edwards & Robert Williams Land, thence along the S. West corner line to a black Oak a corner tree of Land Stephensons and thence along a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree of John Underwoods Land, thence along a line of marked trees along the S. West corner line to a turkey oak a corner tree of John Underwoods Land, thence a line of marked trees to Thomas Edwards Land, thence along the said Edwards Land line to the Beginning, containing by estimation or quantity about be the same more or less, together with all houses, grounds, Orchards, ways, waters and water Courses, mines and minerals & all other profits and commodities therein belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have and to hold the said Bargained premises with the by of the appertinances unto the said Jordan Johnson his heirs and assigns forever, free from and exempt from all service and suit, and of & from all manner, incumbrances, whatsoever and the said John Johnson Senior
