Holloway Curwin Fort and Robert Hines Esqrs. for them or any two of them to execute to whom in any form the said Jesse Browne did make surrender of the aforesaid Bond with other property which said bond with the rest of the said Bankrupts estate was by C. B. Holloway and Robert Hines two of the Comt. aforesaid assigned & conveyed by deed under their hands and seals bearing date the 15th day of November 1800 to Jacob Darden jr. and John Lee for the use and benefit of the Creditors of said Bankrupt and the said Assignment being fully impowered by the Creditors of said Bankrupt at or at their meeting held for that purpose in the town of Petersburg on the second day of May 1801 as will by Deed recited by the major part in Value of the Creditors then present. to cancel make void and utterly annul the said Bond provided the said James Browne in Consideration thereof will render up to the said Assignees or some one or other of them for the proper use benefit and advantage of the creditors of said Bankrupt a certain Tract of Land containing One hundred and sixty two Acres by computation, be the same more or less stated to have been sold by the said Bankrupt to the said James Browne Indue consideration of the premises and having first Received the aforesaid Bond at the hands of Jacob Darden jr. which they the said James Browne & Elizabeth his wife do hereby Acknowledge they the said James Browne and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators hath granted Bargained sold conveyed set over and confirm and by these presents do grant bargain sell convey set over and confirm unto him the said Jacob Darden jr. for the use & benefit of the Creditors of the said Jesse Browne a Bankrupt all that tract or parcel of land lying on the south side of Nottingham River in the County of Southampton which the said James Browne purchased of the said Jesse Browne containing as aforesaid, 162 acres more or less the Boundaries and situation of said Land being designated and more particularly described by deed from the said Jesse to the said James Browne for the same and recorded in the County Court of Southampton To have and hold the said Bargained premises unto him the said Jacob Darden Assignees or aforesaid his Heirs
