This Indenture made this ninth day of January in
the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred
and two between Elizabeth Howell (relief of Hartwell
Howell as) of the state of Virginia and County of Hampton
of the one Part, and Alfred Howell of the state and
County aforesaid of the other Part, Witnesseth that the
said Elizabeth Howell for and in Consideration of the sum of
one Dollar Current money of Virginia to her in hand paid
by the said Alfred Howell, the receipt whereof the said
Elizabeth Howell doth hereby acknowledge she the
said Elizabeth Howell have granted bargained sold
aliened & confirmed & by these presents do grant, bargain
sell, alien and confirm unto the said Alfred Howell all
heirs and assigns forever all and every part of my right
of Power which I profess have, or of right ought to have
or in Law could have of and to a certain tract or parcel
of Land containing by Estimation two hundred and eighty
seven acres late the property of Hartwell Howell etc.
