This Indenture made this Fifth day of June in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and one Between Josiah Vick friendly Guarantier to Sally Sally and Elizabeth Hines children and orphans of Howell Hines deceased late of the county of Sampson and state of Virginia of the one part, and Nathaniel C. Allen surviving partner of William Bennett and company late Merchants and partners transacting the mercantile business in the said county of Sampson in and the Firm of William Bennett and company of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said William Bennett and company did purchase of the said Howell Hines deceased in his life time a certain Tract or parcel of land lying on the North side of Nottingham River in a place called and known by
