This Indenture made this 31st day of December 1801 between
Thomas Cammings of Southampton county of the one part and James
Wilkinson of the said county of the other part Witnesseth here as
by aIndenture bearing date the 13th day of April 1792 made between
the said James Wilkinson and Thomas Cammings there was con-
veyed by the said James Wilkinson certain tracts of land described
in the said deed in Trust to the said Thomas Cammings to Secure
the payment of three hundred and eighty two Pounds one Shilling
and three pence from the said James Wilkinson to the said Thomas
Cammings as by the said deed recorded in the County Court of Kent
on the 11th day of October 1792 reference thereto being had will more
fully appear and whereas the said Cammings having Received full
payment of the aforesaid sum is willing to Release the aforesaid
Tracts of land mentioned as above containing fourteen hundred and
thirteen acres called and known by the Dawson and Sucher Tracts -
Now this indenture Witnesseth that the said Thomas Cammings as
well for the premises as of the sum of one Dollar to him by the said
Wilkinson in hand paid as or before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof the said Cammings doth
hereby acknowledge hath granted remised released and forever
quit claim abate by these presents doth grant remised release and
forever quit claim unto the said Wilkinson and to his heirs and
assigns forever all the estate right title Interest claim and
demand whatsoever of him the said Thomas Cammings in
and to all the property conveyed to him by the said deed of trust
above mentioned so that neither he the said Thomas nor his heirs
nor any person for him shall have claim challenge or demand
