 two between William Kirby of the state of North Carolina
 and County of Wake of the one part and Brittain Williams
 of the state of Virginia and County of Hampton of the
 other part doth witness that the said William Kirby
 for and in consideration of the just sum of one hundred and
 thirty pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand
 Paid by the said Brittain Williams before the sealing
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the
 said William Kirby and Sarah his wife doth hereby
 acknowledge and thereupon quit and discharge the said
 Brittain Williams his heirs executors & administrators
 and themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied
 contented and paid he the said William Kirby and Sarah
 his wife hath granted bargained sold alien released
 set over delivered enfeoffed and confirmed unto the said
 Brittain Williams his heirs and assigns forever and by
 these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff
 release set over deliver and confirm unto the said
 Brittain Williams his heirs and assigns forever one
 certain tract and parcel of Land situate lying and being
 in the County of Hampton aforesaid containing by
 Estimation one hundred and seventeen and a half acres
 of Land be the same more or less and being all the
