This Indenture made this twenty first day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and one Between Sol^l Vick & Julia his wife of the County of Sampson and State of Virginia of the one part and Edward Shelby of the County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Sol^l Vick and Julia his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of one thousand and Sixty two pounds ten current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Edward Shelby at and before the signing sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Sol^l Vick and Julia his wife doth hereby acknowledge and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien mortgage and forever confirm unto the said Edward Shelby his heirs or assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in the County of Sampson and parish of St Lukes bounded as follows Beginning at a small gum corner tree at the fork of the great branch and Alleyway Branch running up the said great branch and the various courses thereof to a large pine the dividing line between John Thomas Benjamin Jordan and the said Sol^l Vick thence a line of marked trees to a small Pine the dividing line of Ben^g Jordan thence along a line of Marked trees to a dead Pine & corner tree the dividing line of Ben^g Jordan and Reubin Whitfield thence along a line of
