This Indenture made this 15th day of
February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and two between William Simmons Daniel Butts Moody
Collier and Michael Ellis Gentlemen trustees
appointed by the worshipful court of Southampton of the
one part and Benjamin Kirby of the county of Hampshire
and parish of Mattoway of the other part writing forth
that they the said William Simmons Daniel
Butts Moody Collier and Michael Ellis Gentlemen
Trustees for and in consideration of the just and full
sum of seventy pounds current money of Virginia to them
in hand paid by the said Benjamin Kirby, before the
making and delivery of these presents, the receipt
whereof they the said William Simmons Daniel Butts
Moody Collier and Michael Ellis with him by ac-
knowledge and thereto acquit and discharge the
said Benjamin Kirby, his heirs and assigns forever
and themselves therewith fully satisfied contented and
paid they the said William Simmons Daniel
Butts Moody Collier and Michael Ellis Gent^l Trustees
have in pursuance and agreeable to a decree of the
worshipful court of Southampton bearing date
November 1799 granted bargain sold confirmed
released set over delivered and confirmed and by these
presents doth grant bargain sell alien ch^{ff} off
Release set over deliver and confirm unto Benjamin
Kirby and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain
plantation messuage tract and parcel of one hun-
dred acres of land be the same more or less and being
all the lands whereon Benjamin Stead did
seize and possess and bound according to the
known and reputed bounds thereof and all the houses
out houses edifices buildings orchards garages
woods ways waters and water courses profits
commonages heridatments and appurtenances
whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise
